GETTING HERE

The Whitsundays is located along Queensland's central coast in north-eastern Australia, approximately 1,120 km north of Brisbane and 630 km south of Cairns. Getting to The Whitsundays is easy, whether driving from nearby towns or travelling from the other side of the world.

✈ AIR

The Whitsundays has two airports, Whitsunday Coast Airport, Proserpine (PPP) and Great Barrier Reef Airport, Hamilton Island (HTI). Flights are available from Brisbane, Cairns, Melbourne and Sydney. Brisbane, the capital city of Queensland, offers the best range of connecting flights into the region from other cities across Australia.

A range of transfer options will take you where you need to go from both airports.

🚗 ROAD

The Bruce Highway is the national highway (A1) linking Queensland's coastal cities and towns. The Bruce Highway runs through Proserpine and Bowen, with Airlie Beach and Collinsville located approximately 20 and 50 minutes, respectively, driving off the highway.

Major national coach operators include The Whitsundays in their regular scheduled services to Proserpine, Bowen and Airlie Beach from all major centres along Australia's East Coast.

🚆 RAIL

Queensland Rail Travel services include the Spirit of Queensland, linking Proserpine to all the major destinations from Cairns to Brisbane.

GETTING AROUND

Local transport company Whitsunday Transit connects guests between Proserpine and the surrounding areas of Airlie Beach. They service as the Translink public transport bus company and offer transfers from Whitsunday Coast Airport and train station. There are also several rental car and taxi services available.

Bowen, the northern jewel of The Whitsundays,
sits on the shores of Edgecumbe Bay, only
one hour north of Airlie Beach.

This picturesque seaside town is a relaxed beachcomber's paradise with award-winning, palm-fringed beaches, beautiful bays and a warm tropical climate. A hidden treasure waiting to be discovered, Bowen boasts a wide range of accommodations, including backpackers, caravan parks and exquisite 4-star absolute beachfront apartments.

Eight incredible beaches surround Bowen, offering scenic walking tracks with panoramic views and stunning fringing coral reefs. These bays are perfect for snorkelling — no boat required — walk straight in from the beach!

Golden hour: Bowen is one of the most breathtaking places to watch the sunset. Bowen offers one of the few spots on the East Coast where you can watch the sunset over the ocean from its westward facing beach, Grays Bay!

The **scenic drive** will see you travel through orchards and farmland teeming with wildlife. Far enough away from the tourist hubs to be a country retreat, this close-knit community always offers a friendly and warm welcome to its many visitors and a proper pub feed.

While in the Whitsundays Outback, be sure to visit the Bowen River Hotel on Strathmore Station, established in the 1800s.

This heritage-listed homestead has many stories; some residents even chose to live on as ghosts!

PROSERPINE

Explore the Heart of Country Hospitality only
20 minutes inland from Airlie Beach, in the
charming town of Proserpine.

Proserpine, named by the explorer **George Dalrymple**, pays homage to Proserpina, the goddess of grain and harvest, a fitting tribute to the region's fertile qualities. Since the late 1800s, the local economy has relied on cattle grazing and sugar cane production.

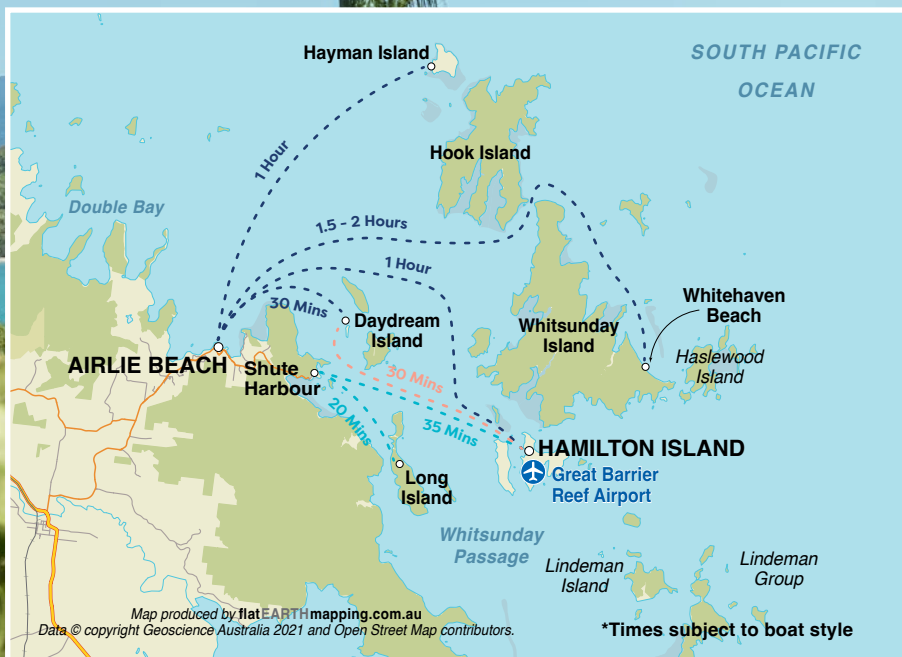

GREAT BARRIER REEF

The World Heritage-listed Great Barrier Reef is one of the world's seven natural wonders and the largest living structure. It is visible from outer space and stretches over 2,000 km in length along the Queensland coast of Australia.

The Whitsundays is located in the Heart of the Great Barrier Reef and is the perfect base to explore this aquatic wonderland. Visitors to the Great Barrier Reef can experience this bucket-list adventure in many different ways. You can do it all on the Great Barrier Reef: swim, snorkel, dive, sail and fly over this natural wonder. You can even sleep there, either under the stars or in the only underwater hotel on the Great Barrier Reef!

Getting to the reef is easy, and many options are available, ranging from old timber sailing boats to fast and sleek motor cruisers.

You can also fly over the reef for a unique perspective. Soar over Heart Reef, a natural heart-shaped formation only found in The Whitsundays, it is the world's most photographed reef. Over the years, many couples have chosen this incredible formation as the site for their proposals and declarations of love.

With so many ways to have your Great Barrier Reef experience – it may be hard to choose just one!



SLEEP on the outer Great Barrier Reef, either under the stars or under the water, on the floating Reefworld pontoon.



SNORKEL OR DIVE the reef on a day trip, with many boats and experiences to suit any travel style.

SNORKELLING & DIVING

The Whitsundays, the Heart of the Great Barrier Reef, is renowned for its world-class diving and snorkelling spots, attracting visitors from around Australia and the globe who seek to explore the stunning coral gardens.

In The Whitsundays, you can snorkel with an abundance of marine life, including green sea turtles and manta rays and over 1,500 colourful fish species, including parrot fish, yellow-tailed fusiliers, clown fish, sweet lip, coral trout and red emperor.

Keep your eyes peeled for an approach by Whitsundays celebrity George (and his many body doubles) - a Maori wrasse who loves interacting with snorkellers and getting in front of your camera! And, of course, the shy clownfish, or 'Nemo', who hides in sea anemones.

DIVING

Scuba diving is a long-standing must-do experience in The Whitsundays, whether you are a complete novice or have some time under your weight belt. There are several diving options, so you can choose a Whitsundays diving adventure to best suit your experience.

SNORKELLING

Many tours offer snorkelling as part of their itineraries with all equipment provided (be sure to check with your operator when booking). Local knowledge is the key to excellent snorkelling in The Whitsundays; your tour guide will choose a favourite spot that suits the weather and tide on the day. Many of the staff on our boats are trained Master Reef Guides or Eco Hosts, ready to answer all your questions and talk you through what you're seeing in the water. There are also some incredible fringing reefs accessible from the mainland, so close to the beach you can walk out to them!

NGARO UNDERWATER MARINE SCULPTURE TRAIL

Avid snorkellers and divers can discover an underwater wonderland thanks to the installation of underwater art in the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park. The unique artworks have been installed at various popular sites around The Whitsundays:

These sculptures provide amazing scenery for guests to enjoy and act as a new base for coral growth and animal shelter. Since their inception, the sculptures have recruited substantial hard and soft corals and invertebrates such as sponges and ascidians (sea squirts). Fish species such as coral trout, surgeonfish and rabbitfish are regular inhabitants of these sites.

These are two bucket list places to tick off during your Whitsundays holiday!

Experience true tranquillity at Whitehaven Beach as you dip your toes into the pristine, crystal-clear water and walk along the untouched coastline. Take a short walk up to one of the lookouts to enjoy the breathtaking beauty of Hill Inlet or Southern Whitehaven Beach. You're guaranteed to reminisce on your memories of Whitehaven Beach and Hill Inlet for a lifetime to come.

GETTING THERE

There is a wide choice of day trips by boat to Whitehaven Beach and Hill Inlet. Most overnight sailing trips also stop in and many self-sufficient boats are drawn to anchor along its peaceful shores. For amazing aerial views, you can see Whitehaven Beach and Hill Inlet by seaplane, light aircraft or helicopter.

HILL INLET

The shifting tides use the northern end of Whitehaven Beach, Hill Inlet, as their canvas. As the tide changes, the white silica sands of Whitehaven Beach, combined with the blue-green hues of the inlet, blend seamlessly to create a swirling fusion of turquoise colours. Hill Inlet is best viewed from above, whether from the lookout (accessed from Tongue Point) or on a scenic flight.

World-famous Whitehaven Beach stretches over 7 km along Whitsunday Island, the largest of the 74 islands in the Whitsunday group. It defines nature at its best, so it's no surprise it is often listed amongst the best beaches worldwide. Experiencing Whitehaven Beach provides an unparalleled sense of relaxation and peace. The sand is 98% silica, giving it a texture similar to baby powder. The soft and fluffy texture surprises and delights even the most seasoned beachgoer.

BETTY'S BEACH

Nestled around the corner from the famous Hill Inlet, this hidden little cove is the perfect spot for lounging on the pristine soft sands and soaking up the warm Whitsundays sun. The red rocks and cliffs against the turquoise water and stark white sand perfectly represent Australia's diverse landscapes.

Getting to Betty's Beach is easy. Once you've visited Hill Inlet Lookout and followed the trail down to the north end of Whitehaven Beach (Hill Inlet Beach), follow the coastline to your left until you hit some rocks. A short hop, skip and jump over the rocks will reveal this secluded little gem.

SOUTHERN LOOKOUT

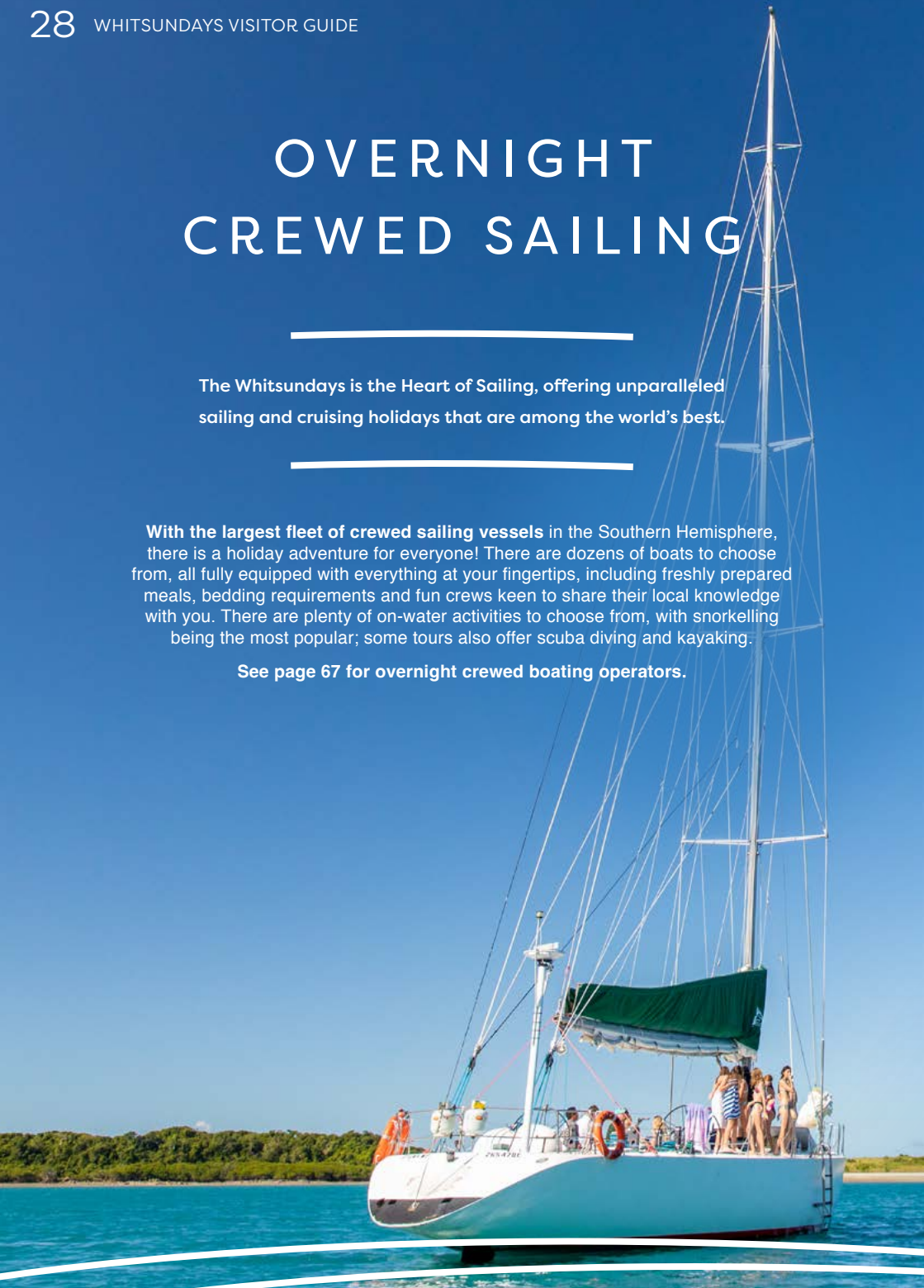
The views are so spectacular and expansive that two lookout points are needed at the Southern end of Whitehaven Beach, each giving a different perspective on this incredible place. The walking track takes you up the hillside, through Australian native bush and local rainforest and to the turning point for your first lookout point. Continue on, and you will get to the top of the short 1 km walk, the Whitsunday Islands National Park opens up before your eyes, and it is every bit as breathtaking as the famous Hill Inlet.

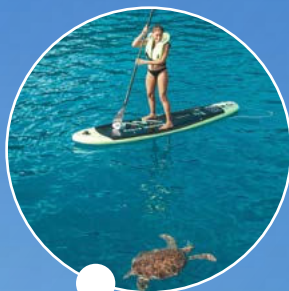

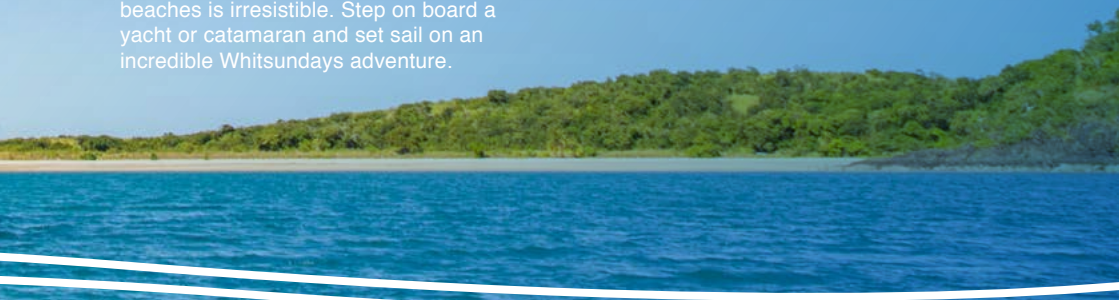

One of the locals' best-kept secrets, Hydeaway Bay and its sister town, Dingo Beach, are situated at the top end of The Whitsundays, accessible by road, 45 minutes north of Airlie Beach. Continue from Hydeaway Bay and you will discover Cape Gloucester, home to a stunning stretch of coastline overlooking the ocean westwards towards Bowen.

Quiet and secluded, these little hamlets are perfect for those seeking rest and relaxation on long, sandy beaches with hardly another soul in sight. These gorgeous beach communities comprise residential and holiday houses, resorts, pubs and restaurants, a caravan park, a boat ramp, a bowls club and a tennis court. They are the perfect holiday destinations to soak in the serenity.

Pack a picnic, do a little beachcombing, and cast a line off the beautiful, almost-empty beaches. Just a few kilometres down the road from Hydeaway Bay, you will come to

Cape Gloucester, overlooking Shag Islet and Gloucester Island. Cape Gloucester is an idyllic tropical escape with palm tree-lined beaches and sparkling turquoise waters.

With endless horizons and picturesque water views dotted with islands, these three communities are perfect for long, lazy days spent wandering and exploring the calm bays by kayak or stand-up paddle board.

CONWAY NATIONAL PARK

Some hikes within Conway National Park will take you to secluded hidden beaches, with others leading to the most beautiful ocean views, the perfect reward for getting in those steps. Conway National Park is accessible from many points on the mainland, **check out our walks menu on page 39 for more details.**

CEDAR CREEK FALLS

Explore Cedar Creek Falls, a haven of natural beauty and tranquillity, the perfect place for a dip in clear, fresh water. Like a well-kept secret, this spot is hidden away behind trees and rocks. As you walk down the path to the falls, the trees and bushes give way to a gem of a location with a loyal following. Surrounded by

cedar trees, a sheer rock face and a cascading waterfall (in the wet season), ending in the sparkling water hole, Cedar Creek Falls is rightly named. Although this spot is beautiful all year round, it is especially vibrant after a downpour. This picturesque beauty is located 30 km from Airlie Beach or 20 km from Proserpine.

CONWAY BEACH

Conway Beach is located on the southern Whitsunday Coast, approximately 30 minutes drive from Airlie Beach and Proserpine. A small hamlet, along with Wilson Beach, Conway Beach is a popular spot for fishing and wind-powered sports such as kite surfing and land kiting. The 2 km sandy stretch of beach is situated at the mouth of the Proserpine River, an excellent location for fishing and crabbing.

WALKS

There are many beautiful places to walk in The Whitsundays with ancient flora and fauna and some unique Indigenous wildlife. Most walks are self-guided. These are just some of the many and varied walks on offer.



AIRLIE BEACH

AIRLIE CREEK TRACK | The track winds you through tranquil forest, which is home to magnificent fig trees, sub-tropical plants, beautiful native birds and ends up at scenic natural rock pools.

 1.7 km return  1 hour

BICENTENNIAL WALKWAY | The waterfront walk stretches from Airlie Beach's lagoon through to the sands of Cannonvale Beach. It is a great choice for photographers or travellers wanting to capture some top travel snaps – particularly at sunset.

 4 km one way  1 hour

MT ROOPER CIRCUIT | Take a challenging uphill walk through open woodlands with a grass tree understorey. Soak up the panoramic vista of the Whitsunday Passage and islands. Head downhill to join the Swamp Bay track, then turn left to return to the car park.

 5.4 km return  2.5 hours

CORAL BEACH | Enjoy a fantastic walk to Coral Beach, with glorious views across the Whitsunday Passage.

 2.2 km return  1.5 hours

HONEYEATER LOOKOUT | This rugged track is a favourite for those up for a fitness challenge, and the views out over the Coral Sea are worth every step.

 8.2 km return  3 hours

CONWAY CIRCUIT (Whitsunday Great Walk) | This is a serious hike, and it is recommended that you take 3 days and 2 nights to complete the track. Don't let this deter you, though; plenty of short tracks deviate from the main circuit.

 27.1 km one way  8 hours  4 hours

BOWEN

CAPE EDGECUMBE TRAIL | The walking trail starts at Horseshoe Bay and includes stops at the Rotary Lookout, World War II Radar Site Lookout, Murray's Bay, Mother Beddock Lookout and Rose Bay.

 2.5 km one way  1.5 hours

ISLANDS

HILL INLET LOOKOUT TRACK | Take an uphill wander to multiple lookouts for stunning vistas over Hill Inlet's turquoise waters and white, sweeping sands. Access the track from Hill Inlet Beach or Tongue Bay.

 1.4 km return  40 minutes

SOUTH WHITEHAVEN BEACH

LOOKOUT | This is a premier walk. You'll see Whitehaven Beach's 7 km shoreline with uninterrupted views. There's fascinating rock formations and wonderful views of Whitsunday Island's peaks and the islands dotted in a sparkling sea.

 1.4 km return (Including Headland Track)  1 hour

PASSAGE PEAK – Hamilton Island |

This is a spectacular but challenging walk. Once you have passed this trail's final steep section, you will be rewarded with breathtaking views of The Whitsundays from the highest point on Hamilton Island, Passage Peak.

 2.7 km one way  1 hour

HASLEWOOD ISLAND | Leave Chalkies Beach behind as you walk uphill to the island's rocky headland. Passing through a natural gully of shady eucalypts and grass trees, you are rewarded with spectacular island and sea views from the lookout.

 600 m return  40 minutes

SOUTH MOLLE ISLAND | Head over to this bushwalkers' paradise with superb views over picturesque island landscapes. Pull on your boots and wander through South Molle's grass tree-studded grasslands or past ancient Ngara stone quarry relics up to Spion Kop. A stunning location to ride a bike, the 14 km of tracks cater for beginners and intermediate mountain bike riders.

CARAVAN & CAMPING

Whether you're seeking a back-to-nature camping experience, a beachfront caravan park or lakeside living in the Proserpine hinterland, The Whitsundays has a range of camping and caravanning options.

MAINLAND

If you're travelling in your van, or simply just want to stay on the mainland, there are plenty of caravan parks equipped with powered or unpowered sites and all the facilities you could dream of!

Experience beachfront camping in Bowen, the Heart of Secluded Beaches, or experience the serenity of Lake Proserpine (aka Peter Faust Dam); watch the sunset over the lake and listen to the mountains come alive, observe the cattle grazing and cast a line to try your hand at landing the metre Barra! If you would like to extend your stay and relax lakeside, take

advantage of the upgraded recreational facilities, including toilet blocks and shower amenities. Visitors can stay for up to seven nights, a small camping fee will apply.

If you're looking for an off-the-beaten-path experience, explore outback camping and farm stay options in the rural town of Collinsville. Here, you can immerse yourself in the authentic rural Aussie atmosphere and discover private creeks and off-track treasures. However, checking with the property owner before setting up camp is always important. Also, keep in mind that a 4x4 is recommended to fully enjoy the terrain. If off-track camping isn't to your liking, Collinsville's main town centre has a free 72-hour RV Park for you to enjoy.

If you're not quite ready to roll out the swag, Airlie Beach has you covered! Camp in style with some caravan parks offering glamping tents, complete with all of the modern luxuries, such as an ensuite, kitchen, dining table and air conditioning!

Camping on the Whitsunday Islands is a very special back-to-nature experience. With rugged natural beauty, stunning views at every turn and an abundance of wildlife, you will feel rejuvenated, relaxed and at peace with your surroundings. From your campsite, you can snorkel, swim and explore the many trails that zig-zag across the islands.

The island campgrounds are accessible from Airlie Beach, Shute Harbour and Hamilton Island; select transfer companies can even drop you off, pick you up and rent all your camping equipment!

Facilities vary and are limited to toilets and/or picnic tables. Campers must be self-sufficient. Remember to take fresh water, a gas stove for cooking and insect repellent.

Open fires and generators are not permitted. Please remember to take your rubbish home with you. Visitor numbers are limited to ensure a quality experience. Be sure to book your campsite and purchase your camping permit from National Parks before travelling. Once you're set up, display your camping permit tag prominently on your tent.

Some popular campsites around The Whitsundays include Whitehaven Beach, Cairn Beach, Joe's Beach and Nari's Beach on Whitsunday Island, as well as Paddle Bay and Sandy Bay on South Molle Island.

Winter bonus: from June to September, The Whitsundays is an important calving ground for migrating humpback whales, resulting in regular sightings, so keep your eyes peeled!

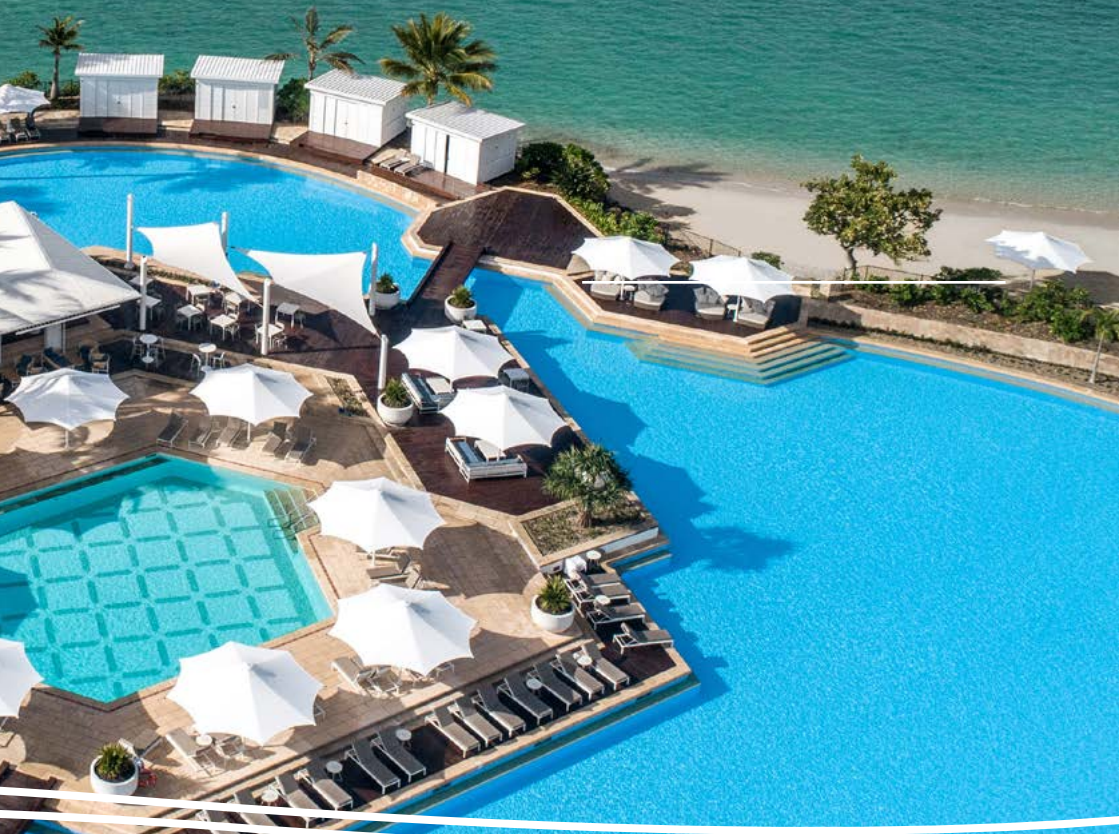

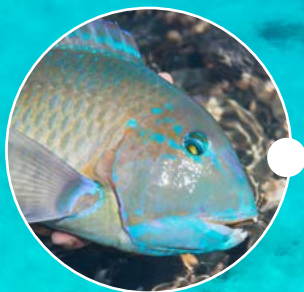
Lake Proserpine (also known as Peter Faust Dam), 20 km northwest of Proserpine, is well known for its impoundment Barramundi, a style of fishing that has become very popular in recent years. Remember, patience is key to catching the iconic and elusive Barramundi!

The most popular fishing spots on the coast near Airlie Beach are the Shute Harbour public fishing pontoon and the VMR Rockwall at Whisper Bay.

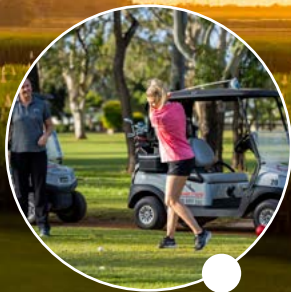

AIRLIE BEACH/CANNONVALE

When holidaying in Airlie Beach or Cannonvale, there's a fun game of golf just down the road. Whitsunday Green is an enjoyable par 3, 9 hole (18 tee) course and driving range. SUSTAINABILITY

Home to one of the world's seven natural wonders, it is incredibly important that every visitor to The Whitsundays builds a connection with nature and leaves with a greater understanding and passion for living sustainably. Tourism operators are addressing climate change by participating in stewardship, innovative research and restoration activities to ensure they can offer guests low-impact tours that conserve our local environment.

WHITSUNDAYS HEALTHY HEART PROJECT

The Whitsundays Healthy Heart Project is an initiative of the Whitsunday Regional Council. The Project was developed to decarbonise the tourism sector and achieve EarthCheck and Sustainable Destination accreditation for the region. The Project provides an opportunity for engaged partners within the local tourism sector to set higher and more ambitious targets for climate change mitigation, to improve the health of our reef and lead the way towards our region achieving a zero net emissions target by 2050.

WHITSUNDAYS REEF RESTORATION

Since its inception in 2018, the Whitsundays Reef Restoration Project has been planting coral fragments around the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park at popular dive and snorkel sites, Blue Pearl Bay, Hayman Island and Manta Ray Bay, Hook Island. As part of the Project, coral fragments have been propagated in coral nurseries before being transplanted onto the reef.

MORE ECO INITIATIVES

The Whitsundays is also proud to be part of the Great Barrier Reef Foundation's Reef Islands Initiative, have over 25 Master Reef Guides in the region, and be home to Eco Barge Clean Seas, which, since its establishment in 2009, has removed 250,166 kilograms of marine debris/litter from the Whitsundays Region.

The Whitsundays is now an official Whale Heritage Area! Staying in a Wildlife Heritage Area helps local communities invest in animal welfare and wildlife conservation, benefitting community well-being and driving forward sustainable practices.

HISTORY & HERITAGE

With a history that spans millions of years, The Whitsundays is a testament to the ever-changing landscape. The 74 islands that exist today were once part of a mainland mountain range, now submerged beneath the sea.

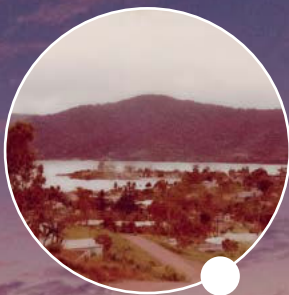
The Ngaro Aboriginal people, also known as the 'Canoe People' or 'Island People', are one of Australia's earliest recorded Indigenous groups and were seen by Captain James Cook while exploring the Whitsunday Passage. The Ngaro people lived throughout the island chain, with the neighbouring tribe Gia inhabiting the coastal mainland and Juru towards Bowen. Rock art and middens at Hook Island's Nara Inlet provide a record of their special way of life and there is also an ancient Ngaro stone quarry on South Molle Island where tools were made.

Proserpine, named after the goddess of fertility, 'Proserpina', is a township that holds a significant place in the region's colonial history. It was established in 1861 on Gia country, with the first settler, Daniel Emmerson, taking up land at Proserpine Station.

In 1871, the thrilling news that gold had been found on the field known as Normanby (southwest of Proserpine in the Clarke Range) spread quickly through Bowen and its surrounding districts. In the coming years, more gold was found in the wider Proserpine area, and settlers continued to migrate to the fertile basin to run livestock and try to get in on the Queensland gold rush action. In the 1880s, more settlers arrived to grow and harvest sugar cane in the naturally fertile basin. Proserpine Central Mill opened the present Sugar Mill in 1897, which stands in the middle of town and processes about 1.5 million tonnes of sugar cane yearly.

Established in 1861 on the traditional land of the Juru tribe, Bowen is North Queensland's oldest town and was even earmarked to be the 'capital of the north' in the 1860s. Salt, beef and coal were all exported from the Bowen Jetty on Front Beach, which turned 157 years old in 2024. The rich culture and history of the town is evident at every turn in Bowen, which is famous for its historic murals on the walls of shops and pubs and also its Catalina museum celebrating the brave pilots who used Bowen as a base in World War II. The Summergarden Theatre, dating back to 1948, is the theatre Baz Luhrmann used to review the day's footage while filming the movie Australia. This cinema is well worth a visit to see the latest movies and peruse the decades of film memorabilia that line the hallway.

Collinsville and its surroundings are rich in mining history and home to many charismatic old pubs, including the heritage-listed Bowen River Hotel. These establishments are great for getting to know the locals and having a few yarns over a counter lunch. In 1912, the Bowen River Coal Prospecting Syndicate was formed to mine coal in the area. In 1917 construction of a railway from the coast to the coalfields began. By 1919, coal was being extracted from an area that, at the time, was known as 'Moongunya' – thought to be the local Aboriginal word for coal. The underground mine was operational from 1919 until the 1960s; this mine is now known as Collinsville's No. 1 Mine and is available for tours.
